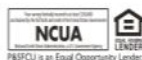

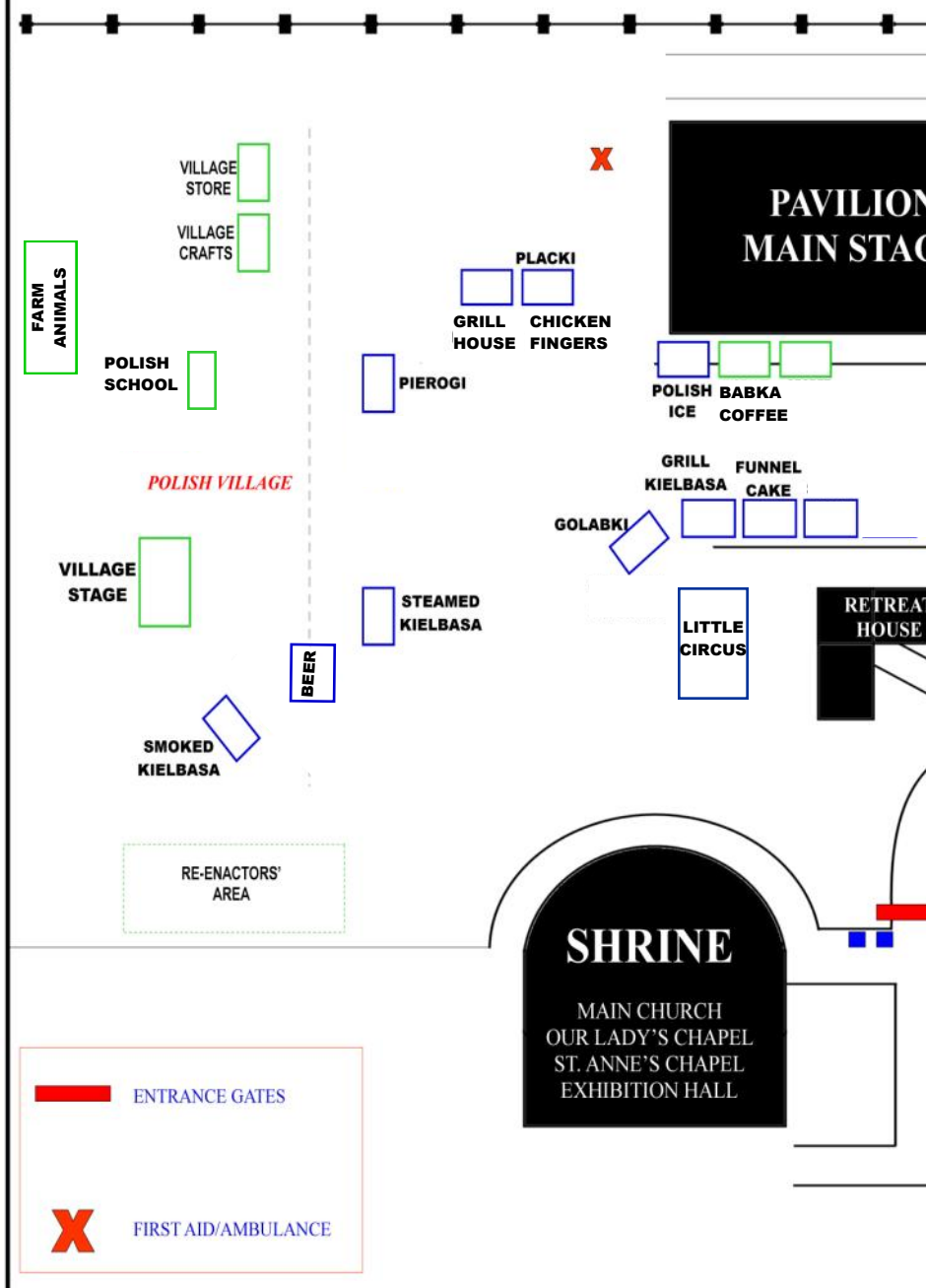

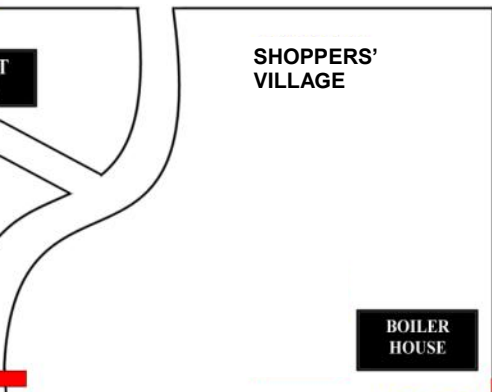

With members based in Maryland, New York, New Jersey, Pennsylvania, Ohio, Virginia and Illinois, we participate in camp displays, tactical events, parades, and other events designed to both explore this fascinating history as well as to educate the public on this remarkable chapter of WW2 that has largely been untold.



World War II Polish Living History Group

The **World War II Polish LHG** is comprised of two separate, recreated Polish units. The 305 Polish Bomber Squadron and 10th Dragoon Regt, 2nd line squadron all fall under the overall umbrella organization. All members are strictly volunteers who have a passion for researching Poland's contributions to the ultimate allied victory in 1945. By bringing the stories, uniforms and equipment out for public display, it is our hope that the general public may come to appreciate the magnitude of Poland's role in WWII. Although our primary representations are these two units, at times our members may choose to tailor their impressions to a specific unit and time frame on a per event basis.
