Mrs. Hall was a volunteer at the very first festival in 1966 and had served


food during every festival until her death this year. Most recently, she worked in the Grilled Kielbasa Booth with her daughter Pat, her sister Elma and her niece Bonnie.





Marking Another Date in Polish History



The 100th Anniversary of Poland's Independence Day November 11th at America's Czestochowa in Doylestown, Pennsylvania

On **Sunday, November 11, 2018,** the Polish American Cultural Center Museum in Historic Philadelphia, invites its members and supporters, Polish American church groups, organizations, veterans, youth groups, dance groups, and all of Polonia, to gather for the **12:30 P.M. Mass at the National Shrine of Our Lady of Czestochowa in Doylestown, Pennsylvania.**

On this day Polonia marks the 100th Anniversary of the reinstatement of Poland's Independence and its restoration on the map of Europe after 123 years of political partitions.

After the enactment of the May 3, 1791 Constitution, the second oldest written democratic constitution in the world, Poland was invaded and partitioned by surrounding countries who feared the spread of democracy to their own lands. On November 11, 1918, Armistice Day, Poland's Independence and its rightful place on the map of Europe were restored.

Everyone is invited to attend the Poland Independence Day Mass at 12:30 P.M., which will be followed by a Tribute to Poland and Polonia in America.




